On the 15th January 1965 steam ceased to operate at the Penrhyn Quarry with Iorwerth Jones signing the cab of Avonside locomotive 'Ogwen' after his last day driving steam in the quarry. After this 'Ogwen' and five other Penrhyn locomotives were sold to American antiques dealer CB Arenette and shipped across the ocean to America.

Our Enthusiast Weekend sees three of the last Penrhyn locomotives reunited, with visiting Avonside 'Ogwen' reunited with Statfold's own Avonside 'Marchlyn' and recently restored Andrew Barclay 'Cegin'. With 'Sybil Mary' and 'GP39' completing the Penrhyn line-up.
